Life Group Discussion Questions:

Note: 1, 8-9 are general questions asked at Pathway weekly.

- 1. How is God at work in and around your life?
- 2. When you hear the phrase "turning points" what comes to mind? How do turning points often define a person?
- 3. Pastor Brian shared the context of Acts 2-9 describing the stories of the Biblical characters (Peter, Stephen, Phillip, and Saul) who had turning points that were used by God to turn lives around. What are some turning points you have experienced in life?
- 4. Read Revelation 12:11 as a group. How does Jesus' blood and our testimony help turn lives around? When is the last time you shared what Jesus has done for you?
- 5. Read Acts 9:1-9. How was Saul "persecuting" Jesus according to these verses? Read John 17:18-21 for further support.
- 6. Read Acts 9:10-18. Pastor Brian shared that both Saul and Ananias had to humbly trust and obey what Jesus was calling them to. Saul would write 2/3 of the New Testament and we never hear from Ananias again. How does this speak to you regarding your life and purpose?
- 7. Read Acts 9:19-21. How do these verses illustrate our church's vision to "be the church: restoring, raising up, and reaching out"? How do you see disciples who make disciples happening at Pathway?
- 8. How did you answer the "next step questions" from the message?
- 9. How can we pray for you and support you this week?
