## PATHWAY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

**Note: 1, 9-10 are general questions asked at Pathway weekly.**

1. How is God at work in and around your life?
2. Pastor Brian said, “our life is giving witness to the real king every day”. Do you agree? Explain.
3. Read Acts 1:8. What does it mean to be His witnesses when “power” comes on us? What does this look like today as the Gospel spreads throughout the world?
4. Who is your “plus one” and how can our group pray for you, and them, as you witness to them?
5. Read Acts 11:18-24. How did the early Church demonstrate lives that had been brought from death to life to the world around them? What made their witness so compelling? How might this help our witness today? Note: The Leonard Ravenhill quote used in the message is: “Jesus did not come into the world to make bad men good. He came into the world to make dead men live”.
6. Read Acts 11:24-26. What were people witnessing and saying about Barnabas and the early Christians? How might this differ from what people see and say today? Note: Pastor Brian did share this in the message as well: “What were the witnesses in Acts saying?”
  - King Jesus was raised from death to life.
  - King Jesus has raised me from death to life.
  - King Jesus can raise you from death to life.”
7. Read 2 Corinthians 6:1-11. Pastor Brian spoke to the issue of our current culture and the need for change. How does this encourage and/or challenge you today in your walk and in your witness?
8. Read Acts 11:27-30 and Mark 8:34-38. Pastor Brian asked, “are you 95% or 100% His?” How did you answer that question?
  - Note: The DL Moody quote used in the message is: ““There are very few who in their hearts do not believe in God, but what they will not do is give Him exclusive right of way. They are not ready to promise full allegiance to God alone” (D.L. Moody)
9. How did you answer the “next step questions” from the message?
10. How can we pray for you and support you this week?
