· The Power of the Bible

- Reflect on 2 Timothy 3:16-17. How does this passage describe the role of the Bible in a believer's life?
- The sermon mentions the Bible as a tool for growth. In what ways have you experienced personal growth through engaging with the Bible?

• The Impact of regular engagement:

- The sermon highlights the "power of 4" days a week in the Bible. How do you think regular Bible engagement can influence behavior and emotions?
- Can you share a personal experience where regular Bible reading has helped you overcome a specific struggle or emotional challenge?

Jesus and the Word:

- How did Jesus demonstrate His love for the Word of God during His ministry, as mentioned in the sermon? Read Matthew 4:1-4; Matthew 22:36-38; Matthew 27:46 and discuss how He was quoting the Old Testament.
- Why is it important for us to follow Jesus' example?

Four Steps to Bible engagement:

- Discuss the four steps to Bible engagement outlined in the sermon: Love, Know, Follow, and Share the Bible. Which step do you find most challenging, and why?
- How can we practically implement these steps in our daily lives to deepen our relationship with God?



- Sharing the Bible:
 - Read 2 Timothy 2:2, NIV and Matthew 5:14-16.
 - Why is sharing the Bible an essential part of discipleship?
 - How can we effectively share the Bible with others in our community or social circles?
- How did you answer the next step questions this week?
 - Do you know Jesus and are you growing with Jesus?
 - Will you commit to the four steps of Bible engagement?
- How can we pray for you and support you this week?
