How is God at work in and around your life?

- 1. Passionate Prayer Changes our World:
 - How does the sermon define "passionate prayer," and why is it considered essential for a Christian's life? How does it change our world?
 - In what ways did Jesus model passionate prayer for us in the Gospels?
- 2. The Role of the Holy Spirit in Prayer:
 - Read Luke 24:44-47. Jesus' passionate prayer led to the curtain being torn in two and our access to the Holy Spirit given (further study Hebrews 10:19-22).
 - Reflect on the quote by A.W. Tozer: "The Holy Spirit never enters a man and then lets him live like the world." How does this relate to the practice of prayer?
 - How can we ensure that our prayers are led by the Holy Spirit rather than our own desires?
- 3. Practical Steps in Prayer:
 - Read Luke 11:1-14. How did Jesus teach us to pray?
 - Discuss the P.R.A.Y. method (Praise, Repent, Ask, Yield) mentioned in the sermon. How can this simple method enhance our prayer life?
 - What are some practical ways to make prayer a conversational and non-performance-based practice?
- 4. Community and Prayer:
 - How does the sermon emphasize the importance of praying with and for others within the church community?
 - What role does the prayer team at Pathway play in fostering a culture of prayer within the church? How could you participate? See opportunities here: www.pathwayvb.com/prayerteam
- 5. Experiencing God's Abundance:
 - According to Ephesians 3:14-21, how does passionate prayer reposition us to receive God's abundance?
 - Can you share a personal experience where passionate prayer led to a significant change or blessing in your life?
