6. Read Daniel 2:36-45. These verses show Daniel's conviction, courage, and graciousness as he boldly shares what God has shown Him. How might this help us as we live out our faith today?
7. The interpretation of the dream was prophetic, and it has come true historically. How does this table below that Pastor Brian shared encourage you today?

<input type="checkbox"/> Chest and arms of silver	=	Medo-Persian Empire (539-331 B.C.)
<input type="checkbox"/> Middle and thighs of bronze	=	Greek Empire (331-63 B.C.)
<input type="checkbox"/> Iron legs and feet of clay/iron	=	Roman Empire (63 B.C. -A.D. 476)
