WHAT'S MY NEXT STEP?

Growing in generosity is a vital part of following Jesus as one of His disciples. This giving journey lays out different places you might currently be in your own generosity journey. We encourage you to ask this simple, but challenging question: what is the next step God is leading me to take in regard to my giving?

As you consider your next step to the "generous life" we encourage you to:

- Lean In: Put God first by sitting down with your Bible, praying, and reviewing your life to see where your need to trust Him more. (Proverbs 3:5-12)
- **2)** *Listen:* Prayerfully seek God's guidance for your giving using both reason and revelation. (Matthew 7:7-8)
- 3) Be Specific: Determine specifically how your resources can be used by God to further His kingdom. (2 Corinthians 9:7; Matthew 25:19-21)
- 4) Be Faithful: Take your next step with God by faith and let Him show you His faithfulness as you walk with Him. (Malachi 3:6-12)

FIRST TIME GIVER

I have given at Pathway, but I am committing to give regularly.




YOUR FIRST & FINEST

STRATEGIC GIVING

I give beyond my "first and finest" percentage at Pathway strategically and my life is marked by overflowing blessing to others. This is a person who learns to live off less to give more.



Pathway Group Discussion Questions:

How is God at work in and around your life?

1. Understanding Joyful Generosity:

- How does the sermon define "joyful generosity," and why is it considered core to a relationship with Jesus?
- In what ways does Jesus exemplify joyful generosity according to the passages referenced (Hebrews 12:1-2, Luke 19:1-10, Philippians 4:19)?

2. Personal Reflection:

- Reflect on the question posed in the sermon: "What if everyone in the church gave like I do?" How does this challenge your current approach to giving?
- Can you share a personal experience where you witnessed or participated in joyful generosity? How did it impact you or others?

3. Biblical Examples and Teachings:

- Discuss the story of Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10. How does his encounter with Jesus illustrate the transformation that comes from joyful generosity?
- How does 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 encourage believers to give joyfully? What promises are associated with this kind of giving?

4. Practical Application:

- The sermon mentions tools like Ramsey+ and Financial Peace University. How can these resources help individuals and families deal with reality and learn to practice joyful generosity?
- What steps can you take to "lean in, listen, be specific, and be faithful" in your journey towards a generous life?

5. Community Impact:

- How can a church community collectively embody the principle of joyful generosity? What might be the impact on the wider community?
- Reflect on the quote by Kevin Harney: "If we live free from the entanglements of possessions, people will want what we have." How can this perspective influence our witness to others?

6. What is God revealing to you personally?

- What does it mean to receive Jesus' joyful generosity in your life, and how can this influence your daily actions and decisions?
- Consider the "Pathway to the Generous Life" graphic mentioned in the sermon. What is your next step in this journey, and how can you be intentional about taking it?



- 7. How did you respond to the next step questions this week?
 - Have you received Jesus' and His joyful generosity in your life?
 - Will you join Ramsey + and/or Financial Peace University to deal with reality?
