

- Do you need to refocus on the bigger goals God has for your life and our church?




Pathway Group Discussion Questions:


Note: 1, 8-9 are general questions asked at Pathway weekly.

- 1. How is God at work in and around your life?

- 3. Read Acts 15:1-5. What was the primary conflict unfolding in the early church between Jews and Gentiles?
- 4. Pastor Brian shared about the "three buckets" (red, yellow, and green). How does this help frame the conflict in Acts 15 and even help us frame our conflicts and priorities today?
- 5. In Acts 15:6-21 the early church "works the process" to resolve the conflict. Read the five principles (and corresponding verses) below to "a Biblical process for resolving conflict". Which steps challenge and/or encourage you to today (see below):
- A Biblical process for resolving conflict:

Go to the source (Matthew 18:15-17)
 Speak the truth in love (Ephesians 4:15)
 Be timely (Matthew 5:23-24)
 Accept assistance (Proverbs 15:22)
 Yield for the benefit of others (Philippians 2:3-4)
